## Rural Networking: An innovation!

The Rural Development Programme for Greece (RDP) for the programming period 2007-2013, co-financed by the **European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development** is designed and implemented as part of the **national strategy for rural development**. During this period, a very important initiative was established as an integral part of Rural Development Programs in the Member States of the European Union.

For the first time rural **networking** at European and National level is institutionalized, through the establishment of the **European Network for Rural Development (ENRD)** and the **National Rural Networks** (Articles 67 and 68 of Regulation (EC) 1698/2005).

In Greece, was established the **National Rural Network** (NRN), which is funded by the **Technical Support of the RDP** and substantially activated in March 2011 with the staffing of its **Support Unit** (Unit E of the Managing Authority). The **Coordination Committee** of the NRN has undertaken guidance and advisory role.

The **National Rural Network** is a dynamic platform that facilitates the exchange of experiences and knowledge among stakeholders involved in rural development, promoting their active participation and cooperation.

The NRN has a flexible structure, which includes 79 members and is able to be enriched.

Among them are administrative services involved in the management and implementation of the RDP, as well as a number of organizations and institutions related to rural development, representing categories of beneficiaries of the RDP or activated in areas related to its measures, such as:

- bodies of agricultural, agri-food and forestry sector
- ✓ chambers
- √ research centers
- environmental organizations
- ✓ LEADER local action groups

## **According to Plan**

## The main objectives of the National Rural Network are the following:

- Development of members linkages.
- Exchange of views, know-how and experience, as well as the submitting of proposals for rural development.
- Development of skills.
- Identification and dissemination of notable practices related to rural development.
- O Dissemination of the results of the RDP at local, national and european level.
- Promotion of inter-territorial and transnational cooperation, projects under Axis 4
   «Implementation LEADER approach" of the RDP.
- O Close cooperation with ENRD and other National Rural Networks.
- Contribution to the RDP evaluation process.

Through a rational and clear targeting of NRN derive the **priority axes** of the **Action Plan**, where details of the activities that have to be undertaken in order to achieve the objectives are reflected.

The Action Plan was updated and approved - along with organizational NRN Chart - in May 2011.

# From planning to action

The most important actions undertaken within the framework of the NRN relate to:

- Organization of thematic working groups.
- Scientific and technical support on specific issues.
- Conducting seminars, meetings, workshops and conferences.
- Collection and dissemination of notable practices.
- Publications, production of electronic and/or audiovisual information material.
- Creation of databases and data maintenance.
- Constant update of the Greek and English version of the website.

# The Unit that supports

#### The task of the NRN Support Unit includes:

- ✓ Specification and updating of the action plan, action for its implementation, ensuring complementarity of actions with other ones of the Technical Support of the RDP and dissemination of the action results of the members of the NRN.
- ✓ Undertake and coordination of actions, performed for the benefit of members of the NRN.
- ✓ Active participation in activities of ENRD and of Rural Networks of member states.

- ✓ Policy for Rural Development within the framework of the Regional Development

Co-organizationwith the ENRD of the 14th Meeting of the Rural Networks of Member-States of the European Union in Thessaloniki. Along with it a special first meeting of the Rural Networks of Mediterranean Member States, focusing on the development of Mediterranean quality agricultural products was organised. The NRN was declared by ENRD as the «Network of the month».
